
The Teaching Tools Award - With cash value of up to \$1000.00 - will be based upon applications received by our Review Committee from science/math/technology teachers with a 10 Feb 2020 deadline. The winner(s) of the award(s) will be announced in April 2020. Implied with the presentation of the award is a guarantee by the winning school system that the funds received are to be used by the teacher as he/she desires for the purchase of supplies, with the approval of the AFCEA Oversight Committee, and are in addition to those funds already budgeted by the school district for the teacher's classroom.

Prior winners have included teachers from municipal as well as suburban and rural school districts throughout Central New York.

The homework for the winning teacher(s) will be an end of the academic year accounting of the funds that were spent and what the results were for the students.
