The 49th Annual AFCEA, Erie Canal Chapter Golf Tournament will be held at Twin Ponds Golf & Country Club, New York Mills, NY on **Wednesday, August 3, 2011**. The primary purpose of this tournament is to raise funds for the Chapter's Scholarship Program; a secondary purpose is for our members to enjoy a day of fellowship. We request your support for this event.

We are soliciting your company participation in the purchase of playing slots. The cost for a foursome will be \$335. This covers the cost of golf, carts, prizes, refreshments and a donation to the AFCEA Scholarship Fund. Another level of participation is \$155 for a twosome. Both sponsorships are the same as last year.

DoD participants will be charged \$75 per person. A donation of \$335 for four playing tickets will include the cost of two non-DoD participants. A donation of \$155 will include the cost of one non-DoD participant.

Please feel free to recommend potential DoD guests when you send in your entry form. This will guarantee that they will receive an official invitation. DoD guest recommendations will be accepted. These invitations will not be identified with your company and no guarantee will be given as to their actual participation in the tournament. Every effort will be made to accommodate your request, however, final acceptance will be contingent upon the AFRL/AFCEA committee approval.

There will be a **SHOTGUN START at 11:00 AM sharp**. There will be a no-host open bar at approximately 4 P.M. with a deluxe buffet at approximately 5 P.M. at Twin Ponds. All entries will be provided favors and be eligible to compete for golf prizes. The format will once again be a "Modified Scramble." This year, we are limiting the field to 34 teams.
