& SRC SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

The AFCEA Erie Canal Chapter Scholarships are awarded to assist deserving students in furthering their educational objectives. Their program of study must lead to a degree in electronics, electrical engineering, communications, computer engineering, physics, mathematics, computer science, or an information technology allied field.

In 2012, the Erie Canal Chapter will award scholarships for full-time undergraduate or graduate study with individual awards from \$500 to \$3000. Scholarships will be awarded to both college students and high school seniors.

Included in this overall scholarship program is a special SRC sponsored scholarship that is available to students who will be attending or, who are currently enrolled at the State University of New York Institute of Technology (SUNY/IT), in Utica, New York. An additional scholarship has been designated by SRC as a "Minority Scholarship" to be awarded to one of the qualified applicants who must be US citizens or visa-holding Permanent Resident of the U.S. of minority descent. (*African American, Asian, Pacific Island, Native American, Native Alaskan, or Hispanic descent*).

Awards are based upon the relationship cited in paragraph one, demonstrated academic performance, potential, honors, community service, work history, and extracurricular activities. All awards are made on the basis of merit. Applicants must meet the following Eligibility Requirements to be considered:

- Applicants must be candidates for a degree.
- Applicants must be US Citizens.
- Applicants must be from the Central NY region which stretches from Albany to Buffalo.
- Applicants must NOT have previously received two or more such awards from this chapter.


